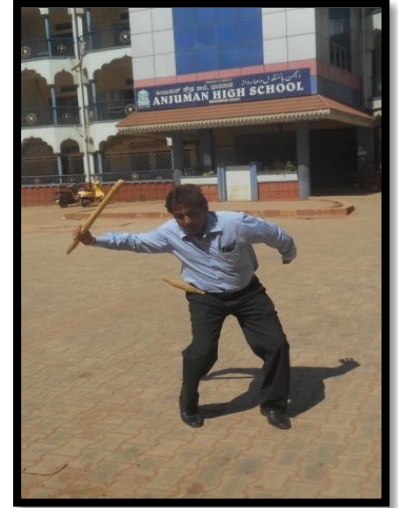
Book Donation Programme by the Students to the College Library on 16.01.2017

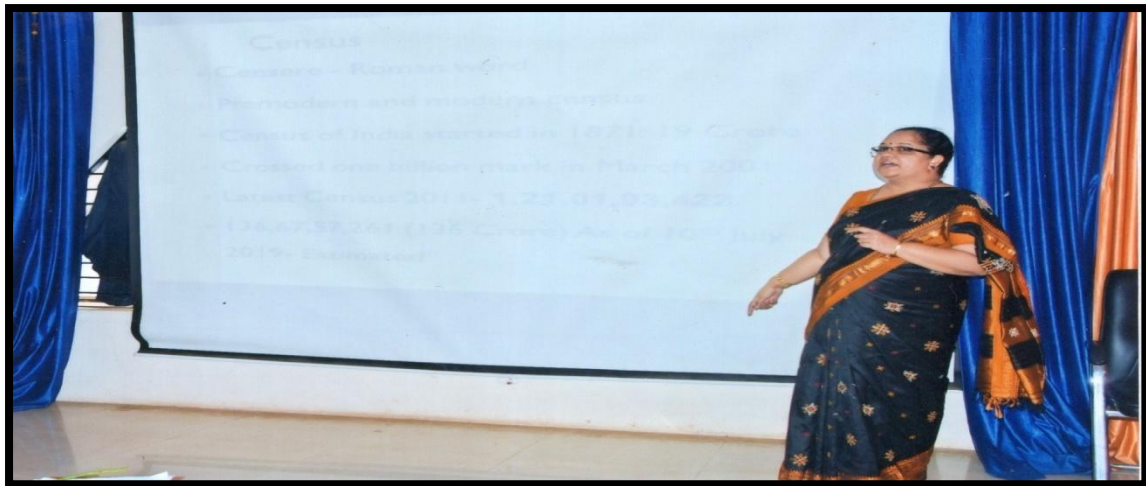
