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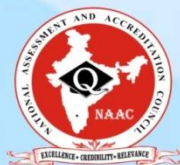

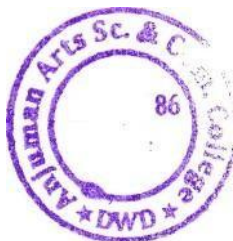
### **Library facilities:**

7. Departments have to modify their department profile to include the certificate courses and value added courses offered.
